Ava Seymour & Peter Robinson Companion Pieces
29 June - 27 July, 2019

In a deceptively simple gesture of abutment, Seymour's cat book cover works bring two seemingly unrelated spheres together; the animal kingdom and the art world. These works seem to refer as much to a fondness for cats as they do monochrome painting from the 60s and 70s.

Complimenting Seymour's work, Robinson has created miniature anodised aluminium sculptures which serve as companion pieces in terms of colour and shape. These simple forms hint to the much larger ensemble on the kitchen table. This work, together with "Constellation", suggests a chaotic cluster of oversized jewellery - the currency of union between people.
